**Why a Whistle?**

- Instant Alert System
- Loud, Recognizable, Impossible to ignore.
- Faster than social media
- Turns silence into community action
- Our voices are stronger together

**WHEN YOU REPORT ICE BE C.L.E.A.R.**

- Count**  
 "2 unmarked white vans carrying 2 ICE agents each"
- Location & Time**  
 "Five minutes ago at 2349 Main St in front of Plaid Pantry"
- Equipment & Clothes**  
 "Wearing masks and vests, carrying guns and zip ties"
- Activity**  
 "Parked and talking on a walkie"
- Record Observations**  
 Record date and time  
 Take photos and videos of agents, vehicles, and license plates



- You can also call about:
- Finding an immigration attorney
  - Mobilizing the community if someone in your family is detained by ICE
  - Finding accompaniment for immigration appointments
  - Finding other community resources

**KNOW YOUR RIGHTS**

- **Do not open the door**  
 Talk through a window or the closed door. Immigration agents need a warrant signed by a judge or your permission to enter or search your home, car, or person
- **If they say they have a warrant**  
 Don't open the door yet. Have them pass it under the door or show it to you through a window while you call a lawyer
- **Don't answer questions**  
**Don't sign anything**  
 Say out loud that you will not answer questions or sign any documents without a lawyer present
- **Take photos, videos, and/or notes**  
 Inform the officer you will be using your right to record. Take photos, record the interaction, and write down the details
- **If you aren't home, ask if you're free to leave**  
 If they say yes, leave calmly
